Leigh Creek Energy Limited appoints General Manager Technical

The Board of LCK welcomes the appointment as it is pivotal for the development of the Leigh Creek Energy Project (LCEP).

Mr Haines has postgraduate qualifications in Geology and Mining Engineering and broad experience across engineering and geological services for multiple commodities including coal, iron ore and uranium. Most recently, Mr Haines worked as Technical Manager for Carbon Energy, an In Situ Gasification (ISG) technology developer who successfully operated their demonstration facility in Queensland under the direction of the Queensland Government's UCG Trial Policy.

In this role, Mr Haines will be responsible for:

- Characterisation of the existing environment at LCEP from environmental, geological, geotechnical and hydrogeological perspectives of the site for low risk ISG project development;
- Demonstrating ISG at LCEP using a low cost rapid deployment technique to provide environmental and gas quality data to inform environmental authorities and commercial project design and feasibility studies;
- Source or develop commercially viable ISG technology and plan for its commercial implementation at LCEP; and,
- Conduct engineering design and feasibility studies to support the selected commercial deployment of ISG at LCEP. LCK will use a best practice approach to project development and intends to utilise existing technologies where viable, or develop better techniques where those technologies don't exist or are otherwise unavailable.
